Opening Protection for Existing Site-Built Single Family Residential Structures

When any activity requiring a building permit that is applied for **on or after July 1, 2008**, and for which the estimated cost is **\$50,000** or more for a building that is located in the wind borne debris region as defined in s. 1609.2 of the Florida Building Code, Building and that has an insured value of **\$750,000** or more, or, if the building is uninsured or for which documentation of insured value is not presented, has a just valuation for the structure for purposes of ad valorem taxation of \$750,000 or more.:

(a) Opening protections as required within the Florida Building Code (Building or Residential) for new construction shall be provided.
