



PRIVATE PROVIDER REQUIREMENTS

You may hire a professional engineer or architect to perform plan review and inspections as per Florida Statutes 553.79. The following paperwork is required:

- Notify Building Official with letter of intent to engage a Private Provider *
- A copy of the Private Provider's State DBPR license
- A copy of the Private Provider's liability insurance policy with a minimum of one (1) million dollar coverage; the City of Plantation **must** be listed as the Certificate Holder
- Required Private Provider Forms *
- Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals Form for Special Building Inspector *
- A Hold Harmless letter from Private Provider *
- A brief synopsis of the private provider's work history and qualifications
- Permit Number of the job

Once authorized, the Private Provider **must** notify the Building Department 24 hours in advance by e-mail of impending inspections and results must follow within 48 hours.
