

**COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM  
PROPOSED USE OF FUNDS FOR FY 2009-2010  
CONSOLIDATED ACTION PLAN SUMMARY**

**INFRASTRUCTURE**

**Road Reconstruction for Park East** **\$222,000**

This project will provide for reconstruction of public roadways in the low to moderate income Park East neighborhood.

**HOUSING**

**Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation Program** **\$113,397**

Providing for the substantial rehabilitation of owner-occupied residential homes, to supplement the City's SHIP program. The primary goal of the Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation Program is to enable income-eligible households to maintain a safe, habitable and suitable living environment.

**PUBLIC AND COMMUNITY SERVICES (Low and Moderate income families)**

**Women in Distress of Broward County Inc.** **\$15,031**

Funding will be made available to Women in Distress of Broward County Inc. to partially fund the salary of a Counselor. The Counselor will be responsible for assisting in providing emergency shelter, individual and/or group counseling, referrals, respite care and fielding phone calls to the domestic hotline from Plantation victims of domestic violence.

**211 Broward** **\$14,821**

Funding will be made available to 211 Broward which provides referral services to all public service agencies throughout the County. This service will allow for continued referrals for Plantation residents to all County public services available.

**Senior Aerobics** **\$22,921**

Funding will be made available to undertake a program to help Seniors with their mobility. The program will be set up with coordination through the City's Parks and Recreation Department. Funding will be used to pay for the trainers' services along with a minimal amount of equipment. Classes for this program will be held at the City's Jim Ward Community Center.

**Broward Homebound Program** **\$6,822**

Funding will be made available to Broward Homebound Program to provide supportive services for homebound residents. The funding will assist Plantation homebound residents with basic household functions that they cannot perform.

**Lighthouse of Broward** **\$5,437**

Funding will be made available to address needs of elderly blind and sight challenged Plantation residents.

**Senior Companion Program** **\$7,242**

Funding will be made available to Senior Volunteer Services to cover a minimal stipend for volunteer services. The volunteers assist frail elderly and disabled adults.

**Fair Housing Education and Outreach Initiative** **\$5,125**  
Funding will be made available to H.O.P.E., Inc. to undertake Fair Housing seminars, brochure distribution and outreach.

**ADMINISTRATION**

**Fair Housing Education and Outreach Initiative** **\$2,375**  
Funding will be made available to H.O.P.E., Inc. to undertake Fair Housing seminars, brochure distribution and outreach.

**CDBG Program Administration** **\$100,824**  
Providing for the overall administration of the CDBG program. Costs include staff and related expenses required for overall program management, coordination, monitoring, reporting and evaluation.

**Total Grant Allocation (FY2009-2010) Proposed CDBG Budget:** **\$515,995**
