NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM (NSP) FUNDS

Pursuant to federal regulations published in the Federal Register at FR-5309-N-01 and regarding Title XII of Division A of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, also known as the "Community Development Block Grant Recovery (CDBG-R) program", the City of Plantation proposes the following activities to be funded under the initial CDBG-R allocation received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development:
