

TOP WATER CONSERVATION TIPS & HOW TO CALCULATE WATER SAVINGS

- Water the lawn only when it needs it. Test it. If you walk across the grass and it springs back, no need to water; if you leave footprints, water the lawn. And follow the Broward County ordinance on designated days and times to water the lawn.
- Use a broom, not the hose, to clean sidewalks, the patio or driveway.
- Refrigerate a pitcher of cold water & avoid wasting running faucet water until it's cold.
- Reduce shower time to 5 minutes to save water and energy. Bathtubs waste up to 70 gallons/minute vs. 10 to 25 gallons for a 5-minute shower. Use a low-flow showerhead.
- Turn off the tap when brushing your teeth and save 8 gallons a day.
- Regularly check your toilets, faucets and pipes for leaks and fix them immediately. You'll save thousands of gallons of water a month.
