



SOLID WASTE GUIDELINES

All City of Plantation single-family residents are **required** to use approved blue bags for the disposal of residential solid waste with the exception of Plantation Acres, Maleleuca Islaes, Lago Largo and Hawks Landing.

Only Plantation Acres, Maleleuca Isles and Hawks Landing are permitted to use rollout carts.

Collection is provided 2 times per week, with no service on Sunday or Christmas day. **Solid waste and recycling material must be placed curbside prior to 7:00 AM.**

On regular pickup days, yard waste tied in bundles not to exceed four feet in length or 40 pounds will be removed **only** when accompanied by a blue bag.

Clear bags of yard debris may be disposed of on garbage days when a blue Plantation bag is tied to them.

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Place all recyclables together in the same toter cart/recycle bag including:



- Plastic bottles, #'s 1-7, such as soda, milk, water, detergent, shampoo (with caps removed)
- Newspapers, inserts, catalogs, junk mail, office paper, soft covered books, folders, cereal boxes
- Glass food & beverage containers
- Flattened cardboard such as shipping boxes
- Aluminum, steel and tin cans

DO NOT RECYCLE: Household garbage including food scraps, pizza boxes, blue glass and miscellaneous plastics such as toys, cups and plastic bags.

Placing these materials in your recycle bag will contaminate clean recyclables.

Recyclables should be clean and free of all food residue before placing them into recycling toter carts/recycling bags.

HORTICULTURE RECYCLING CENTER

The Horticultural Recycling Center (HRC) is located at Public Works, 750 NW 91st Ave. Only natural foliage is permitted including tree branches, palm fronds, bushes and grass clippings. HRC is available to Plantation residents only; proof of residency is required. No material from commercial vehicles will be accepted. Bags of leaves and grass cuttings from lawn mowing may be disposed of for free.

HRC accepts cash only. To use the HRC, present proof of residency and payment to the office personnel. **All charges are subject to change at the discretion of the Public Works Department personnel.**

FREE ORGANIC MULCH: Organic mulch is available free of charge, 24-hours a day, 7 days a week at the following locations: Public Works, Seminole Park, PAL Park and Pine Island Park.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) & ELECTRONICS RECYCLING: Waste products must be in original or clearly marked containers. Proof of Plantation residency required.

There are four quarterly HHW drop-off events at Public Works, 750 NW 91st Ave. from 9:00AM-1:00PM: Dates: 2-20-16, 5-21-16, 8-20-16, 11-19-16

ALTERNATIVE WASTE DISPOSAL SITE

Plantation residents can drop-off HHW, Yard Waste, Bulk and Electronics at Wheelabrator South, 4400 South State Road 7, Davie, FL on Saturdays from 8:00AM to 4:00PM. Closed on holiday weekends. Construction debris restricted to private vehicles such as pickup trucks and SUVs. No commercial vehicles, trailers or large box trucks permitted. Phone: (954) 581-6606

BULK & YARD WASTE REMOVAL

For information or to schedule a special pick-up, call Waste Management at (954) 974-7500.

Bulk waste includes but is not limited to:
 Appliances (with freon removed)
 Furniture
 Carpets and padding
 Yard waste (in clear yard bags)
 Tree branches no longer than 6 ft in length

Items such as carpeting, palm fronds, cardboard or other loose material must be at the curb in a manner that does not exceed six (6) feet in length.

Glass must be placed in a rigid container strong enough that the container may be safely lifted while containing contents.

To expedite the removal process please keep solid waste blue bags separate from the bulk waste.


To prevent property damage, do not place waste near mailboxes, signs, power poles, sewer drains, trees or other structures or objects.

Bulk pick-up items should not be placed at the curb prior to the Saturday before the scheduled pick-up day.
