

City of Plantation Commemorative Program

The Commemorative Program is an opportunity to enrich the lifestyle of the City of Plantation and its residents. It is designed to encourage residents and friends of Plantation to honor someone close to them by purchasing bronze plaques or brick pavers, by planting trees, or by providing benches at parks throughout the City.

Commemorative Opportunities

Brick Pavers

Plaques

These bronze plaques are a great way to pay tribute to an individual who has served in the military. Plaques are mounted in the commemorative wall at Veterans Park and are available in two sizes.

Trees

Remember a particular occasion or person with a tree planted in a City park. Trees, approximately 10' tall, will be planted and maintained by the City. The cost of a commemorative tree is \$600. A 6" x 10" recognition plaque mounted on a rock may be added for \$500. For specific information on a Commemorative Tree, please call 954-452-2514.

Park Benches

Another way residents can recognize friends and family members is through the purchase of a 5' park bench. The cost for a bench is \$2,000 and includes a 3" x 3" name plate. Call 954-452-2514 for more information.

Please note that the placement of benches, trees, plaques, pavers, pickets and planks will be at the discretion of the Parks & Recreation Department.

Some items, such as trees, are installed only twice a year and have specific guarantees and guidelines.
