

## 2020 City of Plantation Kids Day Off Pony Camp FAQs

### **What dates and hours will KDO Pony Camp be taking place?**

Sep 28, Oct 19, Nov 3 & 11 ONLY 8 children will be allowed each day per group. Once a group has filled we will start to fill an additional group, but both groups will need at least 6 participants to move forward. NO last minute day of registrations will be allowed. You must preregister and pay for KDO or you will not be allowed to participate.

Cost per Kids Day Off 60.00 along with a 5.00 City resident registration fee or 10.00 for Non-residents plus tax. Because of the limitations on number of participants and the need for additional staffing, No multi-child discounts will apply this year.

Kids Day Off Camp hours are 9 AM to 4:30 PM, children may arrive as early as 8:30 AM but must be picked up at 4:30 PM.

### **When will registration take place?**

Registration is ongoing until all slots are filled

### **When will payments be due?**

Payment must be made when registering.

### **How will drop off/pickup be conducted regarding social distancing?**

#### Drop off

Children will be dropped off outside of the barn assigned to their group and as indicated in the map that will be sent to you prior to KDO. Guardians will not be permitted to leave their vehicles. A staff member will sign them in. Each participant will have their temperatures taken with a thermo-thermometer every day.

#### Pickup

Guardians will not be permitted to leave their vehicles. A staff member will greet the guardian at their vehicle. Once it is confirmed that the guardian is on the pickup list, the counselor will bring the child to the pickup area.

### **KDO Camps will look different this year, but other than smaller groups and strict social distancing, we still plan on having a great time.**

We still want to keep the fun, our camps are known for. Groups of 8 children will be together the entire time and will not mingle with any other group. Riding times, playtime, lunch, and bathroom trips will all be strictly limited to only those people in their designated groups. The ponies and bathroom trips will be the only occasions that both groups interact with something but separately and those things will be disinfected after each group usage.

### **What should I send my child to camp with?**

Children should bring a lunch, snacks, and liquids. Items must be labeled with the child's name. Items brought from homes such as toys, electronics, and other valuables will not be allowed; cellphones will be

allowed but remain in the backpacks. If found, the item will be placed in a labeled bag and the guardian of the child will be able to pick up the item at sign-out.

**What steps is the City and the Equestrian Center taking to ensure my child is staying safe?**

The City will be following guidelines put forth by the Center for Disease Control, and leading camp organizations.

- Staff will be required to wear face coverings.
- High touch surfaces such as door handles, water fountains, and riding equipment such as reins and saddles, will be sanitized multiple times throughout the day and after each groups riding time or bathroom trip.
- Children will remain with the same group and the same staff throughout the day. Intermingling between groups will be restricted as much as possible.
- Both staff and children will be required to wash/sanitize hands frequently.
- Each group will have a designated area in separate barns. Upon arrival, children will place their belongings in their designated group area.
- There will be no communal eating. Children will eat lunch and snacks in their designated areas. Children will maintain social distancing while eating meals. Children will not be able to share food.
- Any supplies or toys provided for their use will be sanitized after use.
- Any child who complains of sickness or shows symptoms will be removed from their group immediately and be placed in a designated area. The guardian will be called to pick up the child. There will be a strict 72-hour sick policy. If your child has a fever, they cannot return until they are 72 hours fever free without the aid of medicine, as recommended by the CDC.
- The city will encourage children and camp staff to stay home if sick. Steps will be made to safely continue if one of the staff needs to stay home.
- We will provide regular communication with staff and families, regarding any concerns with anyone in the groups who may not be feeling well or stayed homesick.

Please execute your understanding of the City's position in this regard.

I have read and understood the City's position concerning custody rights in the absence of a death certificate on one of the child's natural parents or a Court Order awarding custody to one of the child's natural parents.

**WAIVER & RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS:** Please read this form carefully and be aware of registering your child or ward for participation in this program that you will be waiving and releasing all claims for injuries you or your minor child/ward might sustain arising out of the program.

As a parent/guardian of a participant in the program, I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury and I agree to assume the full risk of any injuries (including death), damages or loss which my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of participation in any, and all activities connected with such program.

I agree to waive and relinquish all claims my minor/ward or I may have as a result of participating in the program against the City of Plantation and its officers, agents, servants, and employees.

I hereby release and discharge the City of Plantation and its officers, agents, servants, and employees from any, and all claims resulting from injuries (including death), damages and losses sustained by my minor child or me arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with negligent acts or omissions of me or my minor child.

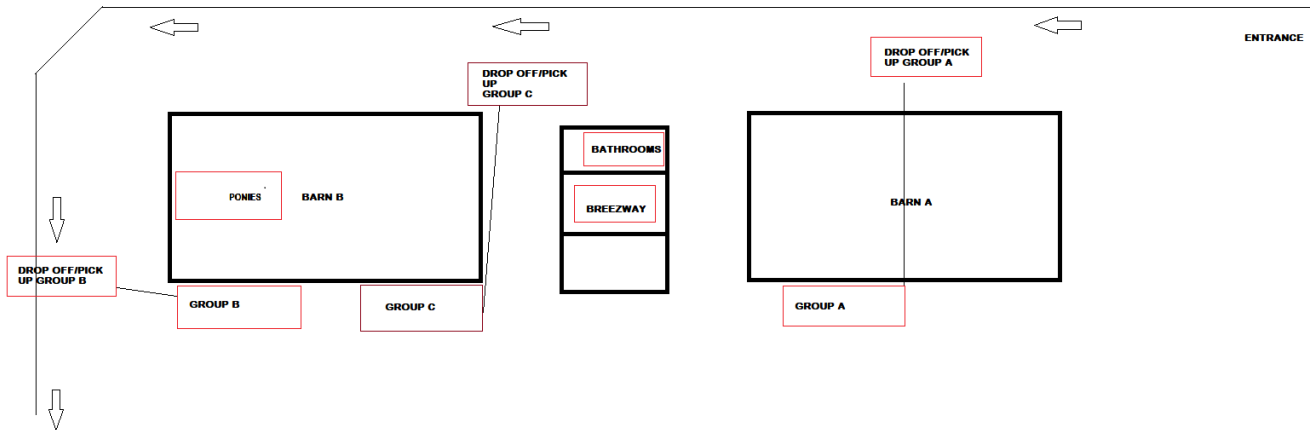
