

## Adult Supervision Required

One adult supervisor to every 10 children.

## Certificate of Insurance Required

A Certificate of Insurance with an insurance company licensed to do business in the State of Florida, with a Best's Guide rating of not less than A+. The Certificate of Insurance shall include Comprehensive General Liability including Property Damage, Automobile Liability, and Worker's Compensation, as required under Florida Law. Minimum limits of total coverage shall be Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury liability and property damage liability. The City of Plantation is to be listed as Additional Insured with respect to each permit. The insurance certificate shall be received and approved by the City prior to the City issuing a permit.

## CITY ORDINANCE No. 2356

## Permits Required

Organized groups and informal groups which are greater than fourteen (14) in number, including supervision, are required to obtain a permit for each use of the City's playgrounds to which this regulation applies.

The City will allow one permit to a group, per calendar year, at no cost. Each permit is for up to a two-hour period of time. Each permit shall cost fifty dollars (\$50.00), with the exception of the one no-cost permit per calendar year.

Proof of Insurance is required prior to issuance of a permit. The permit is non-exclusive, and other patrons may be using the playground at the same time. The City reserves the right to limit the time of day of use; limit the day of week of use; and the right to issue permits for parks other than the park requested.

The City also reserves the right to deny a permit to those groups not following the rules, policies and guidelines established by the Parks & Recreation Department.

Permits must be paid for at least ten days in advance of the scheduled use. Non-payment of the permit by the required deadline date will void the permitted scheduled use.
