The City of Plantation Fire Department operates two (2) pumper trucks and two (2) ladder trucks that are 25 to 43 years of age. All four (4) apparatus have exceeded their useful life expectancy and high maintenance costs (ex: parts no longer available - high cost for custom repairs) demand that the apparatus be replaced. Four (4) new state-of-the-art apparatus will be purchased and placed into operation to replace the existing apparatus. The apparatus are custom-built to City of Plantation Fire Department specifications.
