FIRE STATION NO. 1 REPLACEMENT

Bond Funds Allocation: \$4,500,000

Other Funding Sources: \$1,500,000 - State of Florida Appropriations Grant

Architectural Consultant: Leo A. Daly Architects – Miami, Florida

Fire Station No. 1 is the City's oldest fire station. The existing single-story fire station is in need of replacement to accommodate increased staffing and operational needs. The City will demolish the existing fire station and replace with a new state of the art 2-story fire station complete with emergency generator. In order to accomplish this project, the existing station operation must be temporarily relocated to another location within the property boundary. A modular building is envisioned for staff with an adjacent canopy style vehicle storage area to keep emergency vehicles out of the elements.

Design Development drawings are scheduled to be received from the consultant in August 2018. A complete design with preliminary permit approval ready for public bidding is projected for January 2019.
