An existing 4' wide concrete sidewalk and 4' wide asphalt path run parallel to each other along the west side of SW 54th Avenue from Peters Road north to Broward Blvd. and along the north side of NW 8th Street (a/k/a Plantation Road) from NW 69th Avenue east to East Acre Drive.

The sidewalks and asphalt paths are in fair to poor condition and their separation has led to an inefficient use of the amenity. The City will remove existing sidewalks and paths and replace with a single 8' wide concrete multi-use trail. The City will design this project through 'in-house' Engineering Department resources utilizing field survey prepared by a consultant.

Project Status (as of July 23, 2018):

Field surveying is complete. 'In-house' design will begin in August 2018 and be completed by November 1, 2018. The project will be placed out for public bids accordingly.
