Memory Tree

Celebrate a life, honor a memory, or create a lasting legacy with a Memory Tree. For a minimum donation of **\$250**, a tree will be planted in one of our beautiful parks. Requests for a specific park are welcome; our Parks and Recreation Department will give final approval for the tree's location, size, and variety to ensure the best care and placement.

Bronze Plaque

Veterans Park offers a meaningful way to honor the memory, service, and sacrifice of individuals who have contributed to our country. A custom-inscribed bronze plaque provides a lasting tribute; crafted with dignity, respect, and built to endure for generations. Each plaque is cast in solid bronze and mounted on the commemorative wall at Veterans Park. Two sizes are available:

- **3" x 12" plaque – \$400**
- **6" x 12" plaque – \$600**

The cost includes the plaque, a personalized inscription, and professional installation on the wall. *(Please allow 6–8 weeks for production. See order form for inscription and mounting requirements.)*

Commemorative Bench

The Commemorative Bench Program offers a heartfelt way for individuals, organizations, and businesses to honor the memory of a loved one, celebrate a special milestone, or mark a meaningful event. Location restrictions.

- **Option 1: Dedicate a New Pride Bench**
Create a permanent place of remembrance. Each bench is crafted from durable, all-weather recycled plastic with a cedar finish. A minimum donation of **\$1,050** includes: Bench, custom 12" x 2.5" engraved plaque, delivery, and professional installation
- **Option 2: Dedicate a New Dumor Bench**
Create a permanent place of remembrance. Each bench is crafted from durable, all-weather recycled plastic with a cedar finish. A minimum donation of **\$2,050** includes: Bench, custom 12" x 2.5" engraved plaque, delivery, and professional installation
- **Option 3: Plaque on an Existing Bench**
Add a personal tribute to a bench already in our parks. A custom 12" x 2.5" engraved plaque can be purchased for a donation of **\$250**.

City of Plantation In Honor Of Program Policy

Please read before signing:

- **Full payment must be received before order submission.**
- Donors may request a specific tree species and/or planting location for new park trees; however, the final selection and placement will be determined by the City.
- The donated tree will not be marked for identification purposes and can not be marked by the donor with ribbons, photos, flowers, or other items.
- The City has no duty to guarantee or maintain the donation tree(s) beyond the guarantee given by the nursery where the tree(s) were purchased.
- The City has no duty to guarantee or maintain the tree(s) that may die or are damaged by vandalism, weather, disease, uncontrollable acts of God, etc.
- Commemorative benches will be ordered at the discretion of the City. While requests for bench placement in a specific area within a park will be considered, the final placement will be determined by the City.
- Commemorative bench plaques (**2.5" x 12"**) and bronzed military plaques (**3" x 12"**) may include up to **three lines of text, with a maximum of 30 characters per line.** Bronze military plaques (**6" x 12"**) may include up to **five lines of text, with a maximum of 30 characters per line.** All text is subject to approval by the City. A design mock-up will be provided for the donor's final approval.
- Commemorative bench plaques are not intended to serve as memorial markers; therefore, birth and/or death dates are not permitted. Inscriptions should consist of simple, thoughtful statements honoring the event or individual(s) being recognized. No logos of any kind are permitted on plaques.
- The commemorative bench/plaque donation period will span 10 years. During this time, the City will provide a one-time replacement—at no cost to the donor—for a bench or plaque that is damaged or stolen. Any additional replacements beyond this one-time courtesy will be the donor's financial responsibility and must be arranged through the Parks and Recreation Department.
- The City reserves the right to relocate any donated park tree, bench, or plaque at its discretion. Should relocation be necessary, the Department will make reasonable efforts to contact the donor to discuss alternative placement options; however, the final decision will rest with the Department.
- This policy does not supersede the regulations or ordinances of any City of Plantation regulating authority.
